SUBJECT: Oral and Vaginal Contraceptives

TO: Personnel Concerned

1. The Medical Aid Station of the 656th Radar Squadron will stock five oral contraceptives; three non-sequential drugs and two sequential drugs, as follows:

Non-Sequential Drugs

Enovid-E  
Ovulin  
Ortho-Nuvum

Sequential Drugs

C-Quens  
Oracon

2. The Medical Aid station will NOT stock diaphragms or interuterine devices.

3. The Medical Aid Station will stock one vaginal cream as follows:


Ortho Cream

4. Any individual wishing to use a drug which is not stocked will have to purchase them locally. There are no exceptions. If an individual desires to switch to a drug which is stocked, a prescription must be presented at the Medical Aid Station for one of the above drugs.

5. Prescriptions will be written for one unit package (usually a 90 day supply) which can be refilled one time. No prescription will be for more than a six month's supply regardless of unit pack.

6. The Navy Clinic will provide examination and writing of prescriptions for personnel interested in using their services. Prescriptions will be accepted from civilian Physicians for any of the above drugs.
