SUBJECT: Selective Reenlistment

TO: ALC Robert M. Soule

1. The Air Force Selective Reenlistment Program requires a periodic screening of the records of all airmen whose enlistments are approaching expiration to identify those who are qualified for reenlistment.
2. On the basis of your performance reports and the recommendations of your supervisors, you have demonstrated that you possess the professional and personal qualifications desired in a career airman.
3. You have been selected for reenlistment subject to reenlistment quota availability. Your selection is a credit to you and reflects the fine record you have established. I extend my congratulations. I sincerely hope you will give very careful consideration to the advantages of further service in a career status.
4. Inform this office of your decision by using the attached letter no later than 30 days prior to ETS, 17 Jan 68. Return this letter as soon as you decide to reenlist; however, hold it until the final date for decision if you are undecided. Remember, a reenlistment quota may not be available if you wait too long.
